Bidders should include their name, address, email, and most reliable contact information with their bid.

Payment will be made by **CERTIFIED CHECK ONLY** for the amount of the successful bid, made payable to "Orland School District 135." No cash, personal check, or credit card will be accepted.

Payment by the successful bidder, and possession of the vehicle, will be made no later than close of business on Monday, April 8, 2019. If the successful bidder does not comply with this deadline, the vehicle will be made available to the next highest qualifying bid.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL OF
SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Orland School District Number 135, Cook County, Illinois, is the owner of certain personal property which is no longer needed for school purposes; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-22.8 of the Illinois School Code authorizes this Board of Education to sell at private or public sale any personal property belonging to the School District and not needed for school purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the President and Board of Education of Orland School District Number 135, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: The Board of Education hereby determines that the personal property described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, is surplus personal property and is not needed for school purposes.

Section 2: That the Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of said property by private or public sale in accordance with Board Policy 4:80 and Section 10-22.8 of the Illinois School Code.

Section 3: All motions and resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 4: If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the other sections, paragraphs, clauses, or provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
